JOURNAL OF VIDEO ETHNOGRAPHY FILM ACCEPTANCE AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made as of the _____ day of _____, 20____, by and between _____ (“Filmmaker”), an individual residing at _____ and DePaul University (“DePaul”), an Illinois not-for-profit corporation with its principal offices located at 1 East Jackson, Chicago, Illinois 60604.

WHEREAS, Filmmaker is the creator/director of the ethnographic documentary film entitled, “ _____ ” (the “Film”); and

WHEREAS, Filmmaker wishes for DePaul to accept the Film for inclusion in its scholarly online journal for documentary films, the Journal of Video Ethnography (“JVE”); and

WHEREAS, DePaul is willing to and accept the Film for inclusion in JVE, pursuant to the terms and conditions outlined below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, Filmmaker and DePaul agree as follows:

1. Filmmaker hereby grants DePaul a three (3) year non-exclusive license to distribute and publicly display the Film online via the JVE website (<http://videoethno.com>), beginning _____, 20__ and ending _____, 20____. Thereafter, Filmmaker grants DePaul the right to retain a copy of the Film for historical purposes in a private JVE archive where it will no longer be available for public viewing.
2. Filmmaker shall retain all other rights, title, and interest in and to the Film, including copyright.
3. Filmmaker represents and warrants that the Film is the Filmmaker’s original work, the Film does not infringe on the intellectual property rights of any third party, and Filmmaker is authorized to grant DePaul the license transferred herein. Filmmaker further warrants that the Film has not previously been accepted by any other scholarly journal, and that the Filmmaker complied with all relevant laws, regulations, and institutional policies in the making of the Film, including those pertaining to research involving human subjects.
4. Filmmaker agrees to indemnify and hold DePaul, its affiliates, subsidiaries, trustees, officers, directors, employees, and agents, past and present, harmless against any claim, suit, loss, liability and/or expense, including reasonable attorney’s fees, arising out of or relating to any breach of AUTHOR’S warranties contained herein.

5. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties pertaining to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, and representations of the parties with respect to the subject matter herein.
6. This Agreement may not be modified, amended, supplemented, or otherwise changed, except by writing executed by both parties.
7. This Agreement shall be applied in accordance with laws of the State of Illinois and any dispute arising under this Agreement shall be resolved solely in the state or federal courts of Cook County, Illinois, each party submitting to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of such court.
